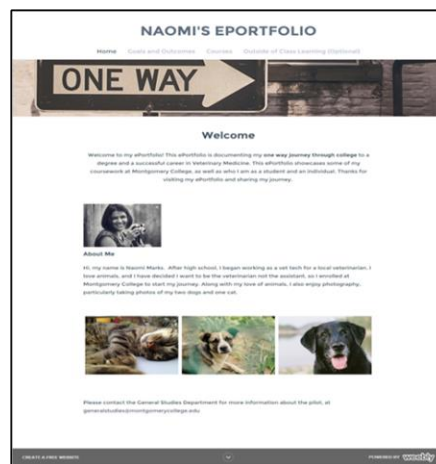

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## What is an ePortfolio?

An ePortfolio (electronic portfolio) is an electronic collection of artifacts that show your learning journey over time. ePortfolios can relate to specific academic fields or your lifelong learning. Artifacts may include writing samples, photos, videos, research projects, observations by mentors and peers, and/or reflective thinking. The key aspect of an ePortfolio is your reflection on the artifacts, such as why it was chosen and what you learned from the process of developing your ePortfolio. You will design and personalize your ePortfolio using one of three available platforms. The required sections for the pilot program are a Welcome page with an About Me section, Goals page, Courses page, and any course specific

requirements from your instructor in this class. After this class, you may use the same site for other classes that require eportfolios, and we hope you will continue to maintain your portfolio on your own.



## What are the benefits of an ePortfolio?

An ePortfolio will allow you to make connections between your learning in different classes, your outside life, and your long term personal, academic and career goals. An ePortfolio showcases your successes as a student. It encourages a reflective habit of mind and helps you see how everything you do here at Montgomery College fits together and leads to your long term goals. Complete ePortfolios can be used to as part of applications to other academic institutions or as part of job applications to demonstrate the depth and breadth your educational experience.



## How do I get started?

### The Writing Center
